


# Go Outside

## Four Square


### What you need:

- 1 Rubber ball
- 1 Piece of Chalk
- Driveway or concrete space



### How To Play

Find a flat, open concrete area - like a driveway or a basketball court. Lie down and mark with the chalk a dot above your head and a dot below your feet. This is how wide each square should be. Draw four squares so that they make up a large square. Look at a map of the US and find the "4 corners" of Utah, Colorado, New Mexico, and Arizona for an example.



Number each square 1-4. The "King", or person in square #4, gets to serve the ball. The ball has to land inside a square before the person in that square can hit the ball to another square. You have to hit the ball with both hands and the ball has to hit the ground inside the square.

If it lands in your square, you must hit it into a different square or you are out. When someone is out, the remaining 3 players move up to the highest numbered square and a new player can enter the game at square #1. The goal of the game is to get to square #4.
